School Health check-up Programme:

As a part of the 'Suvarna Arogya Chaitanya Programme', our health personnel from the Dept. of Community Medicine are performing School Health check-up of around 8,000 children studying in government, government aided and private schools located at Kumarswamy Layout and other areas within the BBMP limits. This being a National Health Programme conceptualized by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, is being implemented all across the Country between August 1st to September 15th, 2011. RRMCH (Rajarajeswari Medical College & Hospital) collaborated with the BBMP (through the Dasappa Memorial Hospital, Town Hall, Bangalore) in implementing this program for the capital population served by the BBMP Urban Family Welfare Centres in the mentioned ward areas of Bangalore.

All the school children were screened for appropriate age based weight/height, dental caries, presence of communicable diseases such as respiratory tract infection, diarrheal illnesses and skin related ailments and non-communicable diseases such as eye problems, vitamin deficiencies, asthma, cardio-vascular diseases and learning disabilities. In-need students were duly referred to RRMCH. Rotary Vasanthapura volunteered in providing logistic support for this programme.
